***First Ladies Revealed* – Smithsonian Channel, Finestripe Productions.** 4x1 hour high-end documentary series in 2016-17 that explored the evolution of the role of the US President's wife from Martha Washington to Michelle Obama. Archive, expert interviews in USA, and dramatic reconstruction.

***Battle of Jutland: The Navy's Bloodiest Day* – BBC 2, True North Productions.** One hour 9.00pm documentary presented by **Dan Snow** in 2016 to mark the centenary of the most important naval battle of WWI. Both a commemoration and investigation into the loss of life, Archive, expert interviews, actuality, and scientific demos.

***Million Dollar American Princesses* – Smithsonian Channel & ITV3, Finestripe Productions.** 4x1 hour high-end documentary series in 2015, presented by **Elizabeth McGovern.** Looked at stories of American heiresses, such as Nancy Astor & Peggy Guggenheim, who came to Europe in the late 19th/early 20th centuries. Archive, dramatic reconstruction, and foreign filming.

***Jet! – When Britain Ruled the Skies* – BBC 4, BBC Docs & Features.** Series of 2 x 1 hour documentaries in 2012 looking at golden age of British aviation in the 25 years following WWII. Combination of archive, expert interviews, and actuality.

***Time Team* – Channel 4, Videotext Communications.** Two episodes in 2010 on long-running, highly popular, award-winning archaeology series presented by **Tony Robinson.**

***Ground War* - PBS & National Geographic, Granada Factuals 2009.** High end series of 4x1 hour docs, covering evolution of warfare. Science demos, archaeology, CGI, & filming with military- US Army & IDF. Filmed in Europe, USA, Israel, and Syria.

Lost Royals – ITV & PBS, Granada Factuals, 2007. One hour genealogical, observational special, presented by **Jennie Bond** who searched for unknowing descendants of the illegitimate offspring of kings of England. Included reconstruction filming with actors.

Battlefield Detectives - History Channel, Granada Factuals. Two series, 2004-2005. One hour docs investigating famous battlefields - *Six Day War, Masada, Alesia, Gettysburg, & Antietam* - using science demos and historical recon. Filmed in Israel, France, & USA.

Secrets of the Dead: Plague on the Western Front - Channel 4 & PBS, Granada Factuals. One hour documentary in 2003 that investigated 1918 influenza pandemic. Filmed in UK, France & USA, and involved considerable historical reconstruction.

Vespasian – The Man Who Saved Rome - Channel 4 & History Channel, Granada Factuals 2001-2002. 90 min doc on Roman emperor Vespasian for C4 season on Ancient Rome. Shot in Italy, UK, Israel, Jordan and Libya, with historical reconstruction.

The Real Spartacus – Channel 4 & History Channel, Granada Factuals, 2000. One hour documentary that investigated slave revolt against the Roman Empire and filmed in Italy.

Man vs Earth – Current TV, Zig Zag Productions, 2011. One hour documentary presented by **Sam Branson**. How man tackles nature's extremes. Branson vs snow, including challenges such as being buried in authentic avalanche conditions. Shot in the Rockies, USA.

Secrets of Body Language - History Channel, Granada Factuals, 2008. Two-hour ob doc exploring body language with experts, archive and experiments. Filmed in USA & UK.

Inside Killer Sharks - Sky One, Granada Factuals, 2006. One hour documentary presented by **James May**, who explored what makes sharks such remarkable creatures and culminated in an open water dive with tiger sharks on a remote reef in Caribbean.

Building the Ultimate - Channel 5 & Discovery, Granada Factuals. Two series in 2003-2004. Award-winning, fast-moving 30 mins exploring evolution of innovative technology such as submarines and sky scrapers using CGI, science experiments, and archive.
